We will send an email to your contributions contact to confirm when payments are to be made. The emails will include a remittance advice with the amount of the payment. Your institution name and your institution code will appear in the supplier reference.

Payments in your bank account will show as USS Fund Account.

The supporting information relating to payments sent from our Data Reconciliations team will remain unchanged; e.g. invoices with member details and contribution payment reconciliations (including member details) will continue to be loaded to the employer portal.
